OUR MISSION

Inspired by US Navy SEALs (frogmen), the mission of the joggin' for frogmen race series is to activate communities from around the world to honor the sacrifices of our naval special warfare service members and veterans, and to support the families of our fallen heroes. Our races bring communities together to celebrate the lives of America's fallen and to express our deep gratitude to those still serving.



IMPACT

Over the last 10 years, sponsors of the Joggin' for Frogmen Race Series have been the catalyst that allowed a small idea for a running team to turn into a national race series that honors military service and embodies the spirit of patriotism and philanthropy. Beyond the direct impact on the Naval Special Warfare (NSW) communities and the cities where the races are held, we are building stronger warriors, stronger spouses, stronger children, and stronger communities. Over the last 10 years, Joggin' for Frogmen has raised over 1.4 million dollars in net profit for military families. Surpassing the 1 million dollar mark in contributions to the military community is an accomplishment that the Joggin' for Frogmen team is incredibly proud of and would not be possible without the continued support of our sponsors.



HISTORY

Created in 2011, the original Joggin' for Frogmen 5k Run/Walk was held in San Diego on July 29, 2012. The race honored the one-year anniversary of the Extortion 17 helicopter tragedy in Afghanistan, a tribute to the 30 American warriors and 1 working dog lost that fateful day.

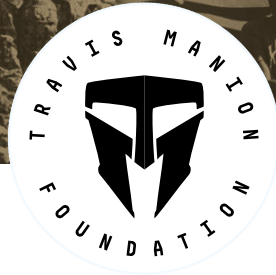
